Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Returning to School Monday 6th September 2021

As we approached the beginning of the summer break, I wrote to say that due to uncertainty, we would wait until the end of the holiday, to give information on dropping off and collecting the children.

Whilst the following may still be open to change, this is how we hope to organise the return.

From Monday 6th September 2021:

Start of the Day:

- Gates 1, 2 and 3 will be opened at 8.30am
- Gate 4 (Ducks and Robins) will be opened at 8.45am (Gate 4 is the nearest gate to the Back Lane entrance)

KS2 children (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6) will be able to access the KS2 (supervised) playground; The children will then line up on the KS2 playground/walled garden and enter the school at 8.45am.

KS1 children (Kingfishers and Woodpeckers) will be able to access the KS1 (supervised) playground. The children will then line up on the KS1 playground and enter the school at 8.45am

Please note: To avoid congestion and keep a form of distancing, we ask that when the children are lined up and ready to enter the building, any parents/carers still on either of the playgrounds, delay their leaving until all the children and teachers are inside. Thank you.

Ducks and Robins children will enter **Gate 4** directly at 8.45am and not via the main playground - we hope this will be a temporary measure. *Please just let staff know if you have other children to drop off and they will make allowances for the time travelled between the drop off points.*

End of the Day:

Ducks and Robins children will be released directly through **Gate 4 at 3.15pm**

Woodpeckers and Kingfishers children will be released onto the **KS1 playground at 3.15pm**

Eagles and Falcons children will be released via **Gate 3** (the main entrance) **at 3.25pm**

Owls, Herons, Doves and Swans will end the day at **3.25pm and then be released from the KS2 playground**

Please note, we fully appreciate that some parents will have more than one child to collect; children will remain with their class adult, until collected.

- THERE WILL **NOT** BE A ONE-WAY SYSTEM (although we do ask parents/carers to be cautious)
- Whilst the wearing of masks is no longer mandatory, we would appreciate the continued wearing of masks, when dropping off and collecting.

Reminder to new EYFS parents/carers:

On the first two days of term, Monday 6th and Tuesday 7th September, children in Reception will finish school at 11.45am.

We have done this most years, to allow new parents to attend a Phonics Workshop. The workshops are on those two early finish days (6th and 7th) and will run from 12.00pm - 1.00pm

The workshop will take place in the Ducks classroom and will be an introduction on how our school teaches reading. Children will be supervised by staff during the session.

Both workshop days will have the same content, so if you are interested, you only need to attend one of the days. Please bring a packed lunch for your child, if you'd like to attend a phonics workshop.

From Wednesday 8th September, children will finish school at the normal home time of **3.15pm**.

Breakfast Club

Lastly, we've been asked about Breakfast Club. This will still need to be booked in advance via Parentmail. The sessions for the new term will be available to book from Monday 30th August – you should receive a notification from Parentmail when the dates go 'live'.

I hope you all have a great last couple of weeks of the holiday and we look forward to seeing everyone soon.
