### Why are we organising the match



For those of you that didn't know Jonathon, known to his teammates and friends as 'Jonny', he first played for Holbeach United Social Club (Holbeach United's 'A' side) in the mid 1990's along with his twin brother Adrian ('Ady'). Jonny was a speedy winger / striker who could play on either flank and consistently chipped in with 10+ goals and 10+ assists per season. He was a committed, reliable, player, who was liked by all his teammates.

Tragically Jonny passed away in September 2012, aged 35 after a long, brave fight against spinal cancer, leaving behind a wife Jane and young daughter Ava.

Since 2013 we have tried to organise as many games as we can (this is the fifth game to date) with the aim to raise monies for charities in his memory. So far, the games that have taken place, have raised over £6,000.00 for St Barnabas Hospice and other charities that have a connection with Jonny's team-mates.
