Dear Parents / Carers

Sports week – 24th – 28th June School Sports Day – Friday 28th June

We will be holding a sports enrichment week from Monday 24th June, culminating in our Sports Day on Friday 28th June.

The theme this year links with the Olympics, which take place in France. The children will have the opportunity to play a French sports game with the Sport2day coaches, learn about and play French Boules with their class and take part in a Hula Hooping session just for some extra fun!

Our school Sports Day is due to take place on Friday 28th June, with Key Stage 2 starting at 9.00am and Key Stage 1 starting at 1.00pm. Parents and carers are invited to bring lunch and picnic with their children, on the field, at lunch time. Please note that **there will be no hot meals**. Willoughby Foods will offer a packed lunch option and all children who receive free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch.

Throughout the week, please ensure your child has:

- their PE kit (Y5 and Y6 to arrive at school 'PE ready' each day)
- trainers / running shoes
- sun hat & sun cream
- water bottle

If possible, please can children in Key Stage 2 wear a coloured t-shirt to represent their house team:

Children in Key Stage 1 will wear their school PE kit on Sports Day.

Unfortunately, we are unable to provide chairs for everyone (as we do not have any 'outdoor' chairs); you are welcome to bring your own if you wish. We have also arranged for toilet facilities to be available on the school field, so parents/carers will have access to a toilet.

Can I please remind you that any images taken during Sports Day are for personal use only and are not to be shared on social media; there are many families who do not wish for their child's images not to be shown, especially on social media, and in some cases are prohibited from doing so.

If Sports Day is cancelled due to inclement weather, we will notify you by ParentMail to advise, as soon as possible. **Please ensure your contact details are up to date on ParentMail**. Unfortunately, due to a very busy term, there will not be a reserve date set aside; if we need to cancel Sports Day, we will hold the event 'in-house' on an alternative day so that the children do not miss out.
