In case you missed the recent letter regarding the new guidance, please note that:



## Willoughby Foods




Please remember to order your child's school meals before the order deadline (midnight on the Tuesday of the week before). If meals are not ordered in time, this creates additional work and if children do not have a lunch, we cannot always guarantee spare meals are available.

#### **Breakfast Club**

Parents / carers need to book Breakfast Club sessions in advance via Parentmail to guarantee their child's place; spaces will be booked on a first-come-first served basis.





Please let the school office know if you need breakfast club and we will add the booking option to your Parentmail account. Currently, the system only allows booking for one week at a time, and the sessions go live every Monday. The sessions close on Thursday lunchtime, or until the sessions are fully booked. The cost of each session remains £2.00 (children entitled to Free School Meals will not need to pay) and **ALL** sessions must be booked in advance, regardless whether they are chargeable or not.

### **Attendance and Punctuality**

If you need to leave an absence message on the school answerphone, please can we remind parents/carers to leave a specific reason for absence i.e. give details if ill. To ensure the safety of all the children in school we do need to know more than 'feeling unwell' or 'not very well'.

Thank you for your understanding.

Reminder: Children <u>must</u> stay off school for 48 hours following any episode of vomiting or diarrhoea.

#### Access

When dropping off and collecting children from Key Stage 2 playground, please can we remind parents and carers to keep the slope to the playground clear - it becomes a little congested at times, and difficult for children and classes to pass through. You may use any of the available space on either playground.

### **Home Time Collection**

Please can we remind parents that children are dismissed by their class teacher, from the playgrounds - at the end of the day, to ensure the safety of our children. We appreciate that this can take several minutes but please do not ask children to leave the lines, as they approach or assemble on the playground.

## Reminder: parking / access



Whilst we appreciate the difficulties regarding the limited parking options, to keep the access to school clear for emergency services (at all times) and for the safeguarding and well-being of children being brought into school and collected by taxi, please DO NOT park in the yellow boxed area or block the car parking spaces outside the staff car park.
