HOME - SCHOOL AGREEMENT

Aim: To develop a shared understanding of the part that home and school has to play in the education of the child.

Parents and Carers

I/We will:

- Let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Ensure that my child attends school, arrives punctually, appropriately dressed and equipped for PE and other agreed activities.
- Provide a note of explanation and telephone the school if my child is absent.
- Encourage my child to read, challenge themselves at all times and with all school work.
- Support & encourage my child to follow the school's rules.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines in relation to behaviour.
- Attends Parent Evenings and discussions about my child's progress.
- Be supportive of the Christian ethos of the school.

The School

The School will:

- Care for your child's safety and happiness.
- Contact you to discuss any concerns or problems that affect your child's work, behaviour or attendance.
- Arrange formal Parent Meetings during which your child's progress will be discussed.
- Encourage your child to read, challenge themselves at all times and with all school work.
- Arrange on request and as swiftly as possible a mutually convenient time to discuss any concerns.
- Encourage your child to respect themselves, the needs of others, to care for their surroundings and to develop a sense of responsibility.
- Set, assess and monitor your child's work in accordance with the school policies.
- Keep parents/carers informed about school activities through letters, diary date lists and information updates.
- Challenge unwanted behaviour positively.

The Child

I will:

- Be helpful and polite to others.
- Listen carefully to what I am told.
- Do all my schoolwork and homework as well as I can.
- Learn my sounds, read my words and my reading book regularly to my grown-ups.
- Tell a member of staff if I have a problem or need help.
- Treat other people and their property with respect.
- Keep myself and my belongings tidy.
- Follow the school rules and values.
