

Creative Crafting


If you enjoy being in a quieter environment and a smaller group, this is the seminar for you.

🎨 **You're an Artist:** Your knife is your paintbrush. You'll use incredible skills to turn every cut of meat into a masterpiece.



Fashion Design


Join us for an exciting fashion design seminar where creativity knows no bounds! This hands-on, creative experience will give you the opportunity to dive into the world of costume design.




Sport Science
